Vision

At Army Public School Dehu Road, our vision is to instill the values of Respect, Responsibility and Relationship to ensure that students are ready for college, career and life.

Our Mission

- 1. In the next three years, the school will develop effective communication skill of students in English at all stages by focusing on their language skills and giving them more opportunities in the classroom and outside.
- 2. In the next two years the school will achieve 100 per cent result in class XII in all streams and also in class X. For this focused attention and involvement from teachers and parents will be sought.
- 3. In the next five years visible positive growth will be achieved in the personal grooming habits, body language and communication skills in students and educators through Holistic Personality Development training to teachers/students from classes I to XII to boost confidence in students and educators.
- 4. In the next two years the school will create an e learning environment so that the teacher educators and students can log on to the net and maximize the use of all apps for education.
- 5. In the next two years at least 25 percent of the children passing out from class XII will be groomed enough for an entry into NDA and TES for a career in the services.
- 6. In the next five years at least five children per academic session will be able to gain entry to national level sports competitions.
- 7. By the next one year school will be a 100 per cent inclusive school with proper identification and addressing of differently abled children using special educators.

Admission Procedure

- Admission to children of Army Personnel coming on transfer will be at any time of the year. Those studying in APS/KV will be admitted directly without an entrance test. For other categories, admission will be made at the start of the academic year based on availability of seats and
- Parents/Guardians of students seeking admission must apply in the Registration form attached in the prospectus. Those eligible for lateral admission may fill up the application form for the admission and complete formalities directly.
- Posting/movement order must be submitted with the application form for admission. 3.
- The following certificates must be submitted along with the application 4.
 - a) Proof of age certificate
 - i) In case of Defence personnel extract copy of DO Part II order notifying the birth of child duly attested by their commanding officer OR
 - ii) Birth certificates issued by Mil/Civil hospital or Muncipality/Village Panchayat.
 - b) TC from previous school for classes II upward. If the school is not an APS/KV the TC should be countersigned by the competent authority i.e, District Education Officer. In case of pupils who did not study in a recognized school the Parent/Guardian should give a letter to that effect.
 - c) Latest Report Card.
 - d) Medical certificate from Military / Civil Hospital.
 - e) Serving Certificate / Field Certificate / Copy Of Discharge

Eligibility

The student should complete 6 years of age on 1st April of the year in which admission is sought to class I. A corresponding scale of age is fixed for the subsequent classes.


• 3 years on 1st April for Nursery • 4 years on 1st April for LKG • 5 years on 1st April for UKG

The entire year has been divided into four terms of three months each and the fees can be paid in four installments. Parents may pay the entire fees, if they so desire, at the beginning of the first term. Fee details can be checked from the school office.

School fees are collected quarterly. Fees to be paid through Digicampus only.

Withdrawal

- Application for transfer certificate should be made on the prescribed form issued in the school diary one week in advance.
- Transfer certificates will be issued only after all dues have been paid.
